



LLAMA BERET

Approximately 100gms double knit alpaca yarn

Colour A: 25gms light colour

Colour B: 50gms medium colour

Colour C: 25gms dark colour

Needles required

A set of 4 double ended needles size **5mm**

Abbreviations

P purl

K knit

M1 make 1 stitch by picking up yarn from below and knitting into the back of it

tbl through back of loop

Llama Beret

Instructions

Cast on 96 sts with colour C (32 sts on each of three double ended needles), join into a round.

P 5 rounds (C)

Next 4 rounds: K 2 (B) K2 (C) repeat to end of round

Next round: K1,M1,K1 (B), K2 (C) repeat to end of round

Next 7 rounds: K3 (B), K2 (C) repeat to end of round

Next round: K1,M1,K2 (B), K2 (C) repeat to end of round, you should have 144sts altogether on your needles

Next 8 rounds: K4 (B), K2 (C) repeat to end of round

Knit 1 round (C) and purl 4 rounds (C), break off C sew end in when beret is finished.

Next round: K (B)

Next rounds: Follow chart below the first decrease in 4th round by knitting 2 together through back of stitches and then every alternate following round knitting 2 together through back of stitches . You need to knit through the back of loop to ensure that the llama's tail comes out attached to the correct llama. This is a 12st repeat pattern, 25 rows.
